



Thank you for entering this event, to be held at Glen Echo Park. 1162 Glen Echo Road, Glen Echo, 4570.

This is an AMA Event and is promoted by Glen Echo Park. All riders:

- - Must have an AMA membership and agree to their guidelines.
- - Must agree to the terms and conditions of Glen Echo Park and sign in on arrival.
- - Must acknowledge the risks of racing and motorsport.

Timed Event.

We will supply your team with a transponder and mounting bracket. If you have a "My laps" compatible mounting bracket, it will be beneficial when changing over a transponder, so bring it along.

A driver's licence will be required to act as a deposit from one team member for the hire of the transponder. Only one transponder per team.

Race Format:

4 person pony express.

Racers must alternate between Senior and Junior (Guardian and Grommet) at every lap changeover. A racer cannot complete consecutive laps. The objective is to complete as many laps as possible, as a team, within the allotted race time. The course is divided into two tracks with a common pit area and start/finish line. Seniors and juniors will have separate gateways leading into the pits to maintain the separation between big and small bikes.

Any junior (Grommet 15 years and under) on a full sized bike (i.e. 21inch front wheel and 18/19 inch rear wheel) will ride the senior (Guardian) track.

Juniors will start the race (basically go first). Juniors will have a sighting lap but not the seniors.

It will be hot so manage your rest time and fluid intake. Ride safe and have fun.

Note: A mixed class can have 1, 2 or 3 of the same gender.

Additional information.

- - Sweep riders and Medics will be visible and present throughout the race.
- - Riders are not to be affected or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- - Each pit must have a 1kg fire extinguisher present and readily available.
- - An approved helmet and motorcycle boots must be worn.
- - Long sleeves, long pants and goggles to be worn. No tear offs.

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- - No riding within the property outside of allotted event times.
- - 10pm noise curfew.
- - Maximum speed within pits is walking pace or first gear only.
- - Rubber based mats or an enviromat to be used in pits area to reduce impact of any minor spills.
- - No riding after the race on Saturday, unless instructed i.e. sweep riders and officials only.
- - Fire restrictions may apply.
- - Report to control, or a sweep rider if you remove yourself from the race for whatever reason.
- - No smoking in race pit area.
- - Pits will be separate from your camping area.

FOOD

The kiosk will be operating with coffee, hot pies, sausage rolls, ice, soft drinks, chips, confectionery and ice creams. The kiosk also stocks basic bike spare parts.

CAMPING

Free camping Friday 29th and Saturday 30th October – Hot showers and toilets are available.

No starting of bikes from 4pm until 8am.

Respect other campers and our environment.

Rubbish to be dumped in a skip provided near the exit gate. Bottles and cans to be recycled in bins provided.

PITS

No dogs in Pit areas.

Pit areas will be allocated.

No camping in pit area.

Slow or first gear in Pit Lane, and when changing with your team members.

Push bikes in your pit areas.

Have your fire extinguisher visible .

SCRUTINEERING:

As per attached form.

Self-scrutineering will apply. Please fill out attached form to have ready for sign in.

Your bike is to be clean and in proper working order. Random checks will be conducted and you will need to rectify any defects before you are permitted to race.

No pit bikes.

Helmet to comply with Australian standards. Boots to be in good protective condition.

Clean your bike, bikes with dirt and vegetation will be sent away.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

All visitors, campers, competitors and spectators must sign in on arrival for Covid contact tracing.

If you feel unwell, do the right thing and do not visit Glen Echo Park.

Maintain social distancing and wash your hands regularly.

Set up your camp area and pit area a minimum of 3 metres away from people not within your group.

If you have been in contact with a person/persons who have had Covid-19 or have returned from overseas, do not come to Glen Echo Park.

Glen Echo Park operates as a Ride park generally and will be open to the public, and friends, to ride on Sunday.

Everybody will be welcome to ride the park for a fee. Contact Glen Echo Park or check out the webpage for more details.

Non competitive riding will start at 9am on Sunday 31st October .

IMPORTANT NOTE..

Access to the park will be restricted during the race. You will not be able to arrive or leave the camp grounds during the race times.

We have made allowances for the emergency services. Please talk to me if you plan on moving your vehicle during the race times, we can park you in a safe spot to leave. Others visitors are not to move vehicles around the property during race times.
